Applicant must have a Master's (preferred) or Bachelor's degree with research experience in a related field. The stipend for MS-level starts at \$17,000 with tuition paid. A higher stipend is paid to a student awarded one of two Fellowships: 1) Distinguished Doctoral Fellowship, or the 2) Doctoral Academy Fellowship (<http://entomology.uark.edu/academics/awards.html>).
