

WORKERS COMPENSATION FACT SHEET

1. THE DIVISION OF AGRICULTURE USES THE ARKANSAS OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH CLINIC IN LOWELL FOR ALL NON-EMERGENCY ACCIDENTS. (LOCATED EAST OF 71 - NEAR J.B. HUNT)
2. THE INJURED EMPLOYEES SUPERVISOR MUST TRANSPORT THE EMPLOYEE TO THE CLINIC.
3. THE SUPERVISOR MUST CALL ALL APPOINTMENTS FOR FOLLOW-UP VISITS.
4. EMPLOYEES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO WASHINGTON REGIONAL WHEN ACCIDENTS OCCUR BEFORE OR AFTER THE LOWELL CLINIC HOURS. (WEEKDAYS 7:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M. AND SATURDAYS 9:00 A.M. - NOON)
5. POISON IVY CAN BE TREATED AT THE UNIVERSITY HEALTH CENTER ONLY WHEN THE SUPERVISOR MAKES AN APPOINTMENT AND TRANSPORTS THE EMPLOYEE.
6. REPORT THE ACCIDENT TO THE DEPARTMENTAL OFFICE AND COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING FORMS IMMEDIATELY AFTER MEDICAL ATTENTION HAS BEEN RECEIVED.
 1. WORKERS COMPENSATION FIRST REPORT OF INJURY - FILLED OUT BY SUPERVISOR.
 2. ARKANSAS WORKERS COMPENSATION COMMISSION WCC FORM N - FILLED OUT BY THE EMPLOYEE.
 3. EMPLOYEE'S REPORT OF ACCIDENT - FILLED OUT BY THE EMPLOYEE
